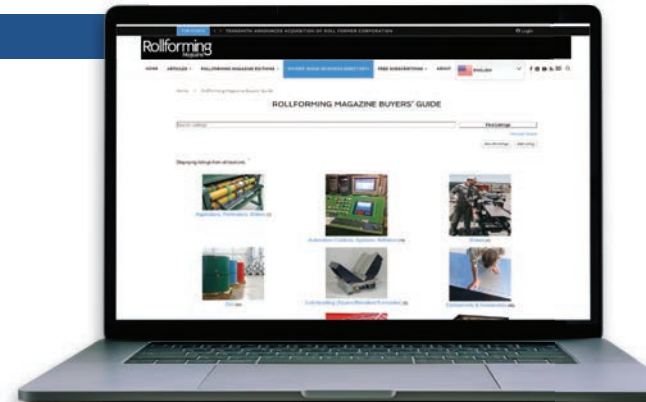
Rollforming Magazine and Construction Rollforming Show are part of a growing network of magazines and trade shows owned by Shield Wall Media.

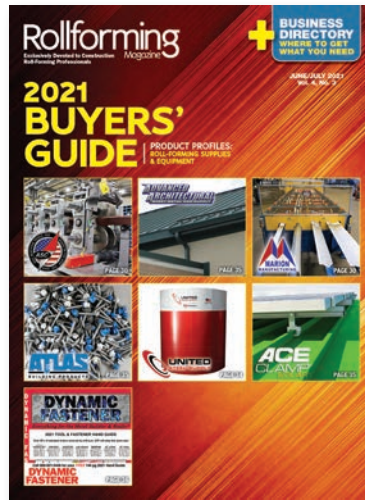
