

# The mikeroweWORKS Foundation Surpasses \$11M in Trade Scholarships

his year, the mikeroweWORKS Foundation is awarding \$2.4 million in work ethic scholarships to more than 300 aspiring tradespeople. As in past years, 2024 recipients include a broad mix of plumbers, electricians, welders, mechanics, pipe fitters, HVAC specialists, blacksmiths, cosmetologists, and many other skilled workers seeking to enter careers that don't require an expensive four-year degree.

"It's been really gratifying to help train the next generation of skilled tradespeople," said Mike Rowe, CEO of mikerowe-WORKS. "The opportunities to prosper in the trades today are astonishing, and shining a light on those opportunities has been a real privilege."

With this latest round of scholarships, Rowe's foundation will have awarded nearly \$12 million in work ethic scholarships to more than 2,000 Americans, making mikeroweWORKS the largest trade school scholarship fund in the country. Along with its scholarship program, mikeroweWORKS is also leading the charge to reinvigorate the trades by challenging the myths and misperceptions that keep so many people from exploring a vocational career.

"It's not enough to simply award scholarships to qualified applicants," said Rowe. "If we really want to close the skills gap, we need to change perceptions in the broadest possible way. That means better PR for the trades. We need to show Americans that lots of skilled tradespeople are making a very comfortable six-figure salary, setting their own schedules, and finding real meaning and fulfillment in their work."

For nearly a decade, the ratio of baby boomers retiring to those entering the





workforce has been 5:2, according to Skillwork. The resulting "skills gap" has widened, and the Bureau of Labor Statistics reported in May that there are 8.1 million open positions—the majority of which do not require a four-year degree-and caused a labor shortage that's left our workforce profoundly out of balance. Meanwhile, the cost of college has soared, leaving nearly 44 million Americans with \$1.6 trillion in student loan debt. And yet, high school graduates are still encouraged—often by wellmeaning parents and guidance counselors-to borrow vast sums of money to attend universities that continue to raise their tuition, leaving millions indebted and untrained for the many vocational jobs waiting to be filled.

"Ever since we took shop class out of high school, we've been telling our kids that the best path for the most people is a four-year degree," said Rowe. "And for decades now, we've been lending money we don't have to kids who can never pay it back, so they can buy a diploma that no longer guarantees them a job. That has to

stop. At mikeroweWORKS, we're telling an honest story about college debt, and making a persuasive case for the many opportunities that exist in the skilled trades. That's what we've been doing since Labor Day of 2008, and that's what we'll be doing this Labor Day. And hopefully, for many Labor Days to come."

f you said yes after reading the question above, congratulations! You are in position to significantly increase your revenue any time your metal forming machine is running. This is an enviable position indeed.



#### **Business Building)**

Using OEE (Overall Equipment Effectiveness) as a standard manufacturing measurement for equipment effectiveness, we can quickly determine if equipment is running at peak capacity. Without delving too deep into the mechanics of OEE measurement, OEE analyzes availability, speed and yield to provide a metric to measure the efficiency of a specific machine. The higher the percentage, the closer to maximum capacity the machine is running. Generally, most roll formers in the U.S. have an OEE of 20% to 60%.

TRUTH: If a piece of machinery has an OEE of 50% or lower, it is only producing half of what it could potentially produce. Which means you've found your hidden roll former!

#### FINDING YOUR MACHINE'S TRUE OEE

The first step to understanding the capacity of your manufacturing processes is to determine the OEE of your individual machinery. The process to uncover your machine's true OEE starts first with benchmarking and the collection of reports to measure equipment availability, performance and output. The quality of these numbers are very important to ensure accurate benchmarks. As such, manual reporting that relies on operators to document run time, down time, changeovers and scrap are not reliable sources of good data. Whenever there is a human element required for the input of data, it's impossible to expect accurate reporting.

# Analyzing the OEE numbers of a machine quickly helps you identify bottlenecks in your processes.

If you are fortunate and have a machine controls partner that understands the importance of OEE and reporting, you are in luck! Machine controls are perfectly positioned to collect valuable data for OEE analysis, all without burdening operators with any manual reporting.

## WHAT TO DO WITH YOUR BENCHMARK OEE NUMBERS

Analyzing the OEE numbers of a machine quickly helps you identify bottlenecks in your processes. Bottlenecks could include issues such as coil changes taking too long, too many unscheduled [stops for] maintenance and repairs, or even high scrap numbers.



Once bottlenecks are identified, the next step is to determine the root cause of the problem. Accurate reporting is critical here to uncover the root causes of the problem. An examination of downtime codes of the bottleneck in question is a good place to start. Of all the downtime codes listed, which are the most common? Which take the longest

to resolve? Which downtime, if solved, will have the biggest impact on productivity? Putting together a cross-functional task force made up of both project managers and operators can help with the process of determining root causes and also devising solutions to reduce or eliminate bottlenecks.

## The Metal Shop's Success Keeps Growing

#### Your Service is Only as Strong as Your Worst Tool

t all began with Emanuel Hershberger. He began his journey in the metal roofing industry at the age of 17 helping his dad in his construction business. At the age of 21 he established and opened his own metal roofing installation enterprise installing hundreds of metal roofs for homeowners and contractors in the Southern Tier of New York. Some of the projects included metal roofs for executives at Corning Glass and installing metal roofing at the Watkins Glen International Race Track. In 2012 Hershberger sold his business and moved back to Michigan

#### **NEW DIRECTION**

Upon relocating to Michigan in early 2013, he identified an opportunity for metal roofing within the predominantly traditional shingle roofing market. Drawing upon his decade of success and expertise, he embarked on a new venture alongside his wife, Esther, founding a roofing business in 2015. With a shared vision and collaborative effort, the business, Central Michigan Roofing, was born. However, it had its own set of challenges; the new market was a bit different from the New York market. Faced with difficulties in finding roofing supplies efficiently, they eventually decided to start roll forming their own panels. Initially, they used a New Tech machine to roll 1" standing seam panels and an MRS Pro-Rib machine for agricultural panels.

Recognizing that others might also struggle to obtain metal panels, Hershberger saw an opportunity to fill this gap in the market.

They began offering their panels to others and quickly discovered a significant demand. Consequently, they transitioned from installation services to full-time manufacturing of metal trim packages, and roofing and siding panels.

#### **TOOLS FOR SUCCESS**

To expand their product offerings, the company invested in an additional New Tech machine, a hemmer from Marion Manufacturing, a slit line from CIDAN Machinery, a board and batten machine from Eastside Machine Company, and a Variobend brake from Hershey's Metal Meister.

By 2019, their thriving operation had outgrown its original premises, prompting the construction of a new 22,000 sq. ft. facility. At the same time, they completely rebranded to closer align with their mission and vision. Thus, The Metal Shop was born.

Hershberger emphasized the importance of investing in new

machinery, selecting the best available tools to ensure highquality service. He believes that a business is only as strong as its weakest tool, driving his commitment to choosing machines that provide the best performance and minimize downtimes.

Getting up to speed on new machines has been mixed he said. A couple of machines they struggled with at first, but the training they received from the manufacturers was, for the most part great, and service on the machines has been pretty good!

Hershberger is a hands-on guy, and he has a few guys on the team who are good problem-solvers, so if a manufacturer can't get out to the facility immediately, the team can usually figure it out between them. "We haven't had much downtime over the years," he said.

#### **MARKETS SERVED**

The Metal Shop services the entire state of Michigan, including shipping projects to the Upper Peninsula. Their customers primarily include the agricultural sector, pole buildings, and residential roofing projects. Over the years, they have also supplied commercial trim packages for projects such as hotels and storefront accents, for contractors, and also helped many DIY enthusiasts install their own projects.

Company offerings include a 36" 5-rib ag panel, multiple standing seam profiles, board and batten panels and trim packages, and all metal roofing and siding accessories.

Their customer base has been built primarily by word-of-mouth, which has kept them busy and fueled their growth.

Recently, they invested in a Thalmann double folder from CIDAN Equipment, upgraded their old machine from Hershey's to a new one coming in 2025, and are planning further expansions to their facility.

#### **EMPLOYEES AND PARTNERS**

The company has nine employees currently, and Hershberger said that while finding the right employees has been hit and miss through the years, they have been blessed to find many great people who make up their current crew. They all pull together to create value for

their customers and try not be pricefocused, ensuring they have the products their customers are looking for. They are all about forging long-term relationships with customers.

Over the years, The Metal Shop has established strong partnerships with Everlast Metals (now Progressive Metals) and Hixwood, sourcing the majority of their metal coils from these companies. Additionally, they offer a range of metal roofing tools from Malco Tools, along with various other suppliers who provide similar tools and accessories.

#### "SECRETS TO SUCCESS"

"There are no secrets to success," Hershberger said, "it requires a lot of hard work, long days, and sometimes even long nights. It takes grit. You need to stay true to your values and be honest with everyone."

That said, Hershberger does have some advice for people starting out. "If you don't have much experience, find people who do have experience and people who are smarter than you are and hire them," he said. "There is always someone who you can partner with, befriend, or hire that can help you with the answer."

Hershberger also emphasized the importance of having a personal reason for your business. For him, it's about helping others and the privilege of working with his family every day. His wife has always been part of the business, and his children are increasingly involved, growing into their roles each day.

The company is experiencing growth, and Hershberger hinted at some significant news to be announced in the fall.

"There are many niches and opportunities in roll forming and metal roofing right now," he added. "It's a great time to join the industry." RF







ach week, Majestic Steel USA [majesticsteel.com], a steel service center that distributes prime, flat-rolled galvanized steel sheets and coils to industries across the United States, compiles the Core Report. The Report is "an in-depth look at key indicators and trends driving the steel market. Market volatility demands your attention about what's driving prices, when and why." Data sources are listed in each section.

Majestic Steel has granted Rollforming Magazine permission to publish information excerpted from the Report for its readers.

## DOMESTIC STEEL PRODUCTION

According to the American Iron & Steel Institute, Weekly Domestic Steel Production report dated June 28, domestic raw steel production increased the week before after sliding the previous two weeks. U.S. mills produced an estimated 1,710k tons at a 77.0% utilization rate; which is up from 1,704k tons and a 76.7% rate previously. Despite the increase, this was down 3% compared to the same period in 2023.

Production rose in three of the five regions, with the largest increase (in tons) coming from the Great Lakes region. Production from the Great Lakes region increased from 554k tons to 568k tons. Year-to-date production is now up 1.7% compared to the same period in 2023.

#### RECENT SCRAP PRICING

According to Prime Scrap for the week ending June 7: Mild demand, falling hot rolled prices, and thinning booked orders resulted in a drop of ferrous scrap metal prices in June. Prime scrap settled at \$380/gt, down \$40 from May and down over 25% since the beginning of 2024. Demand for scrap metal dropped in early June with Summer maintenance outages at Nucor Gallatin, Decatur, and Hickman mills, as well as NLMK's Portage mill. Shredded scrap slipped \$20/gt to \$375/gt.

#### SPOT IRON ORE

The Platts, Spot Iron Ore report ending June 28, indicates that spot iron ore resumed its downward momentum, down four out of the last five weeks. Spot iron ore pricing settled at \$106.35/mt, down from \$107.50/mt the week prior. Chinese steel mills are holding back on iron ore purchases as China's government plans to push steel output cuts this summer.

#### **CARBON STEEL IMPORTS**

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, Carbon Steel Imports report for May 2024: May preliminary carbon steel imports totaled 2.204 million tons, up 7.4% from April and up 29.6% from May 2023. This is the highest monthly total for carbon imports since June 2022.

Carbon flat rolled imports increased as well, climbing to 687,452 tons, up 0.8% from April and up 34.6% from 510,934 tons in May 2023.

While both hot rolled and cold rolled imports declined from April, they could not overcome the sharp increase in coated sheet imports. Coated sheet imports were up 19.7% from April and up 70.1% from May 2024.

On a daily rate, HDG imports (8.44k tons/day) were at their highest daily rate since March 2022.

Year-to-date carbon flat rolled imports are now up 41.3% compared to the first five months of 2023.

#### ZINC PRICE & INVENTORY

Based on the London Metal Exchange, Weekly Zinc Price and Inventory Report and the Shanghai Futures Exchange, Weekly Zinc Inventory Report, both dated June 28: Zinc pricing increased for the second consecutive week, ending the week at \$2,919/mt (\$1.324/lb), up from \$2,785.50/mt (\$1.263/lb) previously.

Despite the increase, zinc is still down nearly 7% since peaking at \$1.40/lb in late May.

Global zinc inventory decreased again, now down for the third consecutive week. LME warehouse inventory decreased from 244,375 metric tons to 239,600 metric tons. Shanghai warehouse inventory decreased from 128,107 metric tons to 126,413 metric tons.

## CSI: Q2 vs. Q1 2024

#### After Receiving Mixed Anecdotal Reports, Roll Forming Survey Reflects Positive Market

e just came back from the first ever Post-Frame Builder Show. One of the great things is the opportunity to talk with builders, dealers, manufacturers and various professionals in our corner of the construction industry. One topic that always comes up is: "How is the industry doing?" Is business up or down, busy or slow, and what is next?

There are a lot of factors that can affect the business climate short term, especially in an election year. The general impression was that Q2 was slower than Q1, with no specific reasons given for the decrease. The story seemed similar across the various markets we serve.

Since we are generating data for the industry, this presented an excellent opportunity to validate or disprove what people were saying. We sent a survey on business climate comparing Q1 and Q2 in late June. The results were interesting.

Rollforming Magazine is about roll forming and metal forming so readers typically function at the dealer/distributor or manufacturer stage of the construction process.

Despite what we heard at the Post-Frame Builder Show, business is reportedly good for manufacturers and dealer/distributors.

Sales in dollars were generally up for Q2 vs. Q1 2024, and for Q2 2024 vs. Q2 2023. These generally were in keeping with expectations. RF
